

Specific Requirements for Criminalistics Proficiency Tests

Fellows that have General Knowledge (GKE) and Comprehensive Criminalistics Examination (CCE) Certification shall utilize proficiency tests from recognized proficiency test providers, when practical. The tests shall consist of samples that require testing beyond screening type tests if the certificate holder is authorized to conduct the full breadth of forensic testing. See documents 09-0711S through 09-0715S for requirements of acceptable proficiency tests and required documentation. Fellows of the GKE and CCE are required to submit the results of each test they perform, annually.
